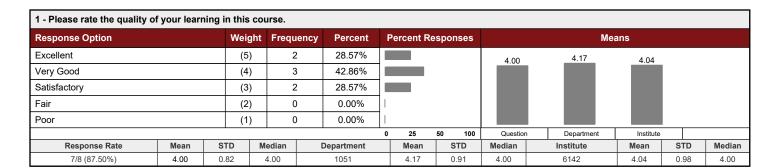

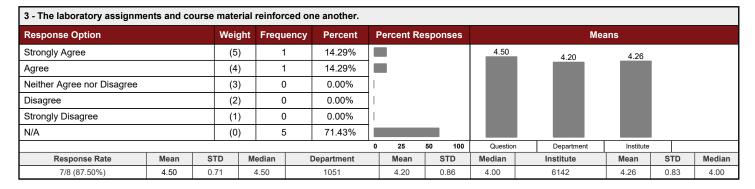

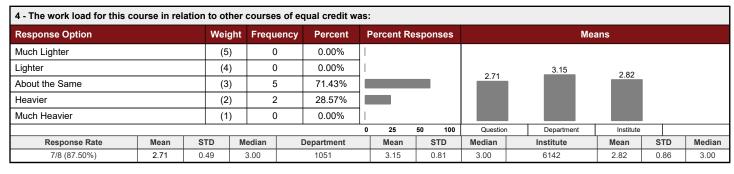


### 2 - Explain why your learning was at this level.

- The classroom was very well reflected on the exams.

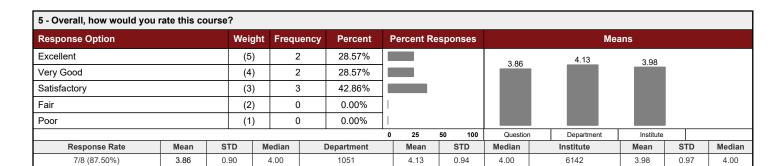

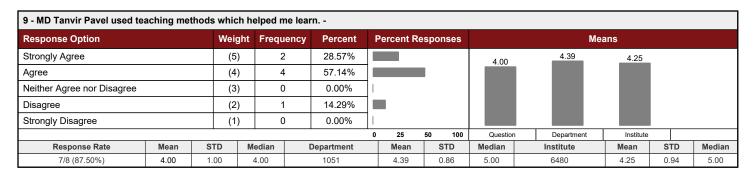
- less focus on research and more focus on material from the book

- The research paper scope can make it hard to pick a topic as time is a huge factor.

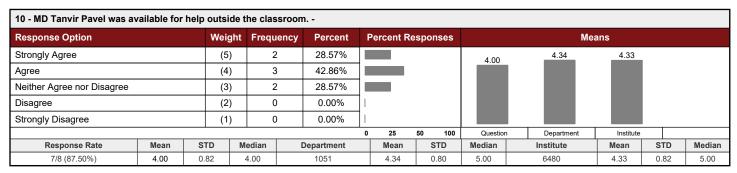

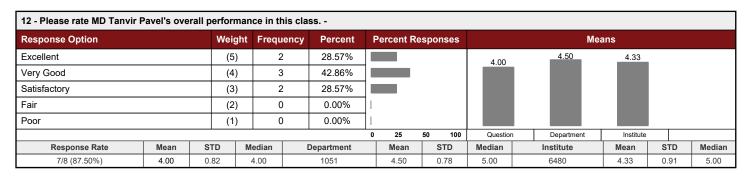

- · Class was interesting to listen to but hard to score well on for the exam and paper.
- Dr. Pavel is clearly very knowledgeable about the class and its subject matter. However, the lectures were sometimes off-topic (or at least seemed like it) and boring/unengaging. Teaching a small class means more opportunity for class discussions about policies and economic ideas or discussions about the different topics each student is researching. The exams and quizzes were also too long for the class length (50 minutes) and the preparation for them were not the best. Some practice exams or practice quizzes would've helped miles in understanding the topic better and thus taking these exams/quizzes better.
- Dr. Pavel always explains the points he made in class very well. The empirical studies he introduced support his ideas and provide examples of how to make an argument.
